Include in government positions from engineer to department head to department manager to assistant general manager to general manager to general manager in particular

- Advisor for more than 25 years of government work before 2003.
- Project manager for several large projects worth 10 - 100 million dollars per project.
- Assistant Director General for the period 1987-1993.
- Director General for the period from 1993 to 2000.
- Advisor for the period 2000-2003.
- Advisor to the Ministry of Finance for the period 2003-2009.
- Governor of Anbar between 2009 and 2013.
- Awarded "Personality of the Year in the Middle East" from the 2009 FDI Magazine of the Financial Times.

One of the projects that participated in the achievement in the field of electric power:

He participated in the electricity reconstruction campaign in 1991 after it was completely destroyed.

He was a member of the National Mobilization Committee, which helped prevent the collapse of the electrical system in 1997.

He was responsible for manufacturing the spare parts for the electrical system after it was prevented from importing it due to the siege.

In the period of administration of Anbar province between the years 2009 and 2013 was the first province among the provinces of Iraq in the disbursement and implementation of the budget allocated for the reconstruction and development projects of regions and provinces, and official books of the Ministry of Finance and Planning and for three consecutive years. Thousands of projects have been implemented in this period, including roads, bridges, schools, health centers, government buildings, parks, sports and entertainment centers, cultural centers, residential apartments, low cost houses, water and sanitation projects and many other projects, as well as projects implemented by state ministries.

This period is a qualitative leap in the history of the province, especially after it was almost completely destroyed by the terrorist acts and US bombing before 2003.

The last government work received before 2003 in addition to being a consultant is the management of a central department called "National Manufacturing Department" whose task is to activate and support the private industrial sector in Iraq and to conduct studies on the prospects of investment and for this purpose a private bank was established with the Ministry of Planning to support projects that The Department is linked to the Industrial Committee and oversees the Ministry of Industry, Transport, Transportation, Oil, Military Manufacturing, Atomic Energy, the Secretariat of the Capital, Ministry of Electricity.

He participated in many studies in investment horizons in the western region of Iraq through working with 108 university professors who were contracted for this purpose. During the period 2001-2003, a large number of preliminary technical and economic feasibility studies were prepared, totaling 483 completed studies and more than 300 studies Was not completed and all this work has been through small groups of professors and scientists were working under the umbrella of "National Industrialization Department" mentioned above, which can be activated again and reviewed in cooperation with Iraqi universities in view of the positive results on the horizon of investment and industry in Iraq.

Minister of Electricity Engineer # Qassem Al-Fahdawi in a television interview:

“We thank the security forces, which have achieved a professional and rapid achievement of their liberation without significant losses
